## #1 Connecting

Select 1 or 2 of the following questions:

- Catch us up on what has been happening in your life recently.
- How have you seen God work in your life recently?
- What has been a high and low in your life recently?

*How do we help each other Connect to God?... Listen to each other, deal with life together at the feet of the savior, encourage each other to apply Biblical principles in daily life, encourage each other to keep our life focused on God, prayer...*

## #2 Into The Word

- Invite God into your group and to guide your discussion through prayer.
- Read Acts 2:1-4
  - Who are 'they'? (see Acts 1:13-15)
  - Are 'they' a small group?
- What can happen when a small group lets God work in their midst? What happened through this small group in Acts?
- Are we willing to let God work in our midst this year? How do we do that?

**-How to use Connecting With God Curriculum:**

*-This curriculum is designed to promote spiritual growth through small group interaction.*

*-It's as easy as '1', '2', '3'!*

*-Read the questions or follow the instructions in Box #1, then #2, and then #3.*

## #3 Praise & Worship

- Spend time in prayer asking God to powerfully work in the group this year and also asking God to reveal to each member of the group how He desires to use us.
- Go around the group and share any prayer needs.\*
- Close the group time together in prayer.

*\*Sharing prayer needs is an opportunity to share life together. It is always easy to ask the group to pray for a neighbor or co-worker but it is not always easy to share with the group what in our own life needs prayer. Go deeper! Be honest with the group and share what in your own life needs prayer.*
