#1 Connecting

#2 Into The Word

- Sometimes a short question can be very powerful. Read: Genesis 3:9, Genesis 4:9, Esther 5:3, Luke 8:25, Luke 9:20, Acts 2:37, and Acts 8:30.
- Why are these short questions so powerful?
- A Life Group can ask easy cheesy questions of each other or they can ask the tough short questions- When and why should a Life Group ask the tough short questions of each other?
- What are some questions this group should be asking you this year? Why?
- Are there some questions you should be asking God? What?

#3 Praise & Worship

- Spend time in prayer lifting up specific requests about fellow members of the group. Consider allowing each person to lift up one other person in a chain prayer.
- Go around the group and share any prayer needs.*
- Close the group time together in prayer.

**Sharing prayer needs is an opportunity to share life together. It is always easy to ask the group to pray for a neighbor or co-worker but it is not always easy to share with the group what in our own life needs prayer. Go deeper! Be honest with the group and share what in your own life needs prayer.*
