- What has been a high and low in your life recently?

#2 Into The Word

-How to use Connecting With God Curriculum:
-This curriculum is designed to promote spiritual growth through small group interaction.

-It's as easy as '1', '2', '3'!

-Read the questions or follow the instructions in Box #1, then #2, and then #3.

- Read Matthew 10:1-10
 - *The American way of thinking is that bigger is better...*
 - Why do you think Jesus chose only 12 people to be his group? Why didn't he choose more?
 - Why was Jesus able to change the world through 12 people, one of whom was a dud?
 - Do you think God could change the world through this Life Group? Why or why not?
- Read Matthew 10:11-20
 - *Jesus reassured his disciples that they should live by faith; God would take care of their needs and the Holy Spirit would guide their words.*
 - Do you believe God can still take care of your needs and guide your words? Why or why not?
 - Do you believe God can still do amazing things through just a few people? Why or why not?

#3 Praise & Worship

- Spend time in prayer lifting up specific requests about fellow members of the group. Consider allowing each person to lift up one other person in a chain prayer.
- Go around the group and share any prayer needs.*
- Close the group time together in prayer.

**Sharing prayer needs is an opportunity to share life together. It is always easy to ask the group to pray for a neighbor or co-worker but it is not always easy to share with the group what in our own life needs prayer. Go deeper! Be honest with the group and share what in your own life needs prayer.*
