Theology

At Sugar Grove Church of Christ, we worship a God that has eternally existed as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.¹ Created in God's image, mankind is called to reflect his communal nature.² Though sin compels us to seek isolation, God continues to form community, first seen in His calling of the people of Israel and today seen in His church.³ We also recognize that God's redemptive work not only saves us from sin but also calls us into a community with other believers.⁴ We believe this community is formed by the outpouring of the Holy Spirit and marked by the perfect unity and love found in the triune God.⁵ The divine calling of this community is to encourage one another, be committed to each other, and present the person and work of Jesus to the world.⁶
