At Sugar Grove Church of Christ, we believe that the life of discipleship is rooted in service to God and neighbor.¹ As we serve, we offer worship to God which demonstrates our living and active faith in him.² We believe that sin spoils service turning our attention inward, placing ourselves over God and neighbor.³ Through the cross Christ conquered sin, assuring us that our service is in no way earning God's approval and mercy.⁴ In this freedom, we find our joyous purpose of serving God and neighbor, just as Jesus did during his earthly ministry.⁵ We serve confidently knowing that our service is empowered and enabled by the Holy Spirit, which God has poured out on each of us to proclaim the Kingdom of God.⁶
